**Program Content Description / Learning Objectives:** Script or life plan consist of sets of thoughts, feelings and behavior patterns that are not good for child's mental health. These patterns are made under stressful situations in which child and usually the family members were in. Using therapeutic play and therapeutic alliance, play therapist can help child to work through traumatic experiences, to reset patterns made under stress. To make this process successful it is necessary that therapist understand family dynamics. In this workshop it will be presented concept from transactional analysis theory – script system and how can play therapist used this knowledge in work with child and parents.

**About the Presenter:** Tatjana Gjurkovic is the co-director of Center Proventus d.o.o., along with her colleague Tea Knežević. Tatjana has a MA in psychology and is a psychotherapist.
